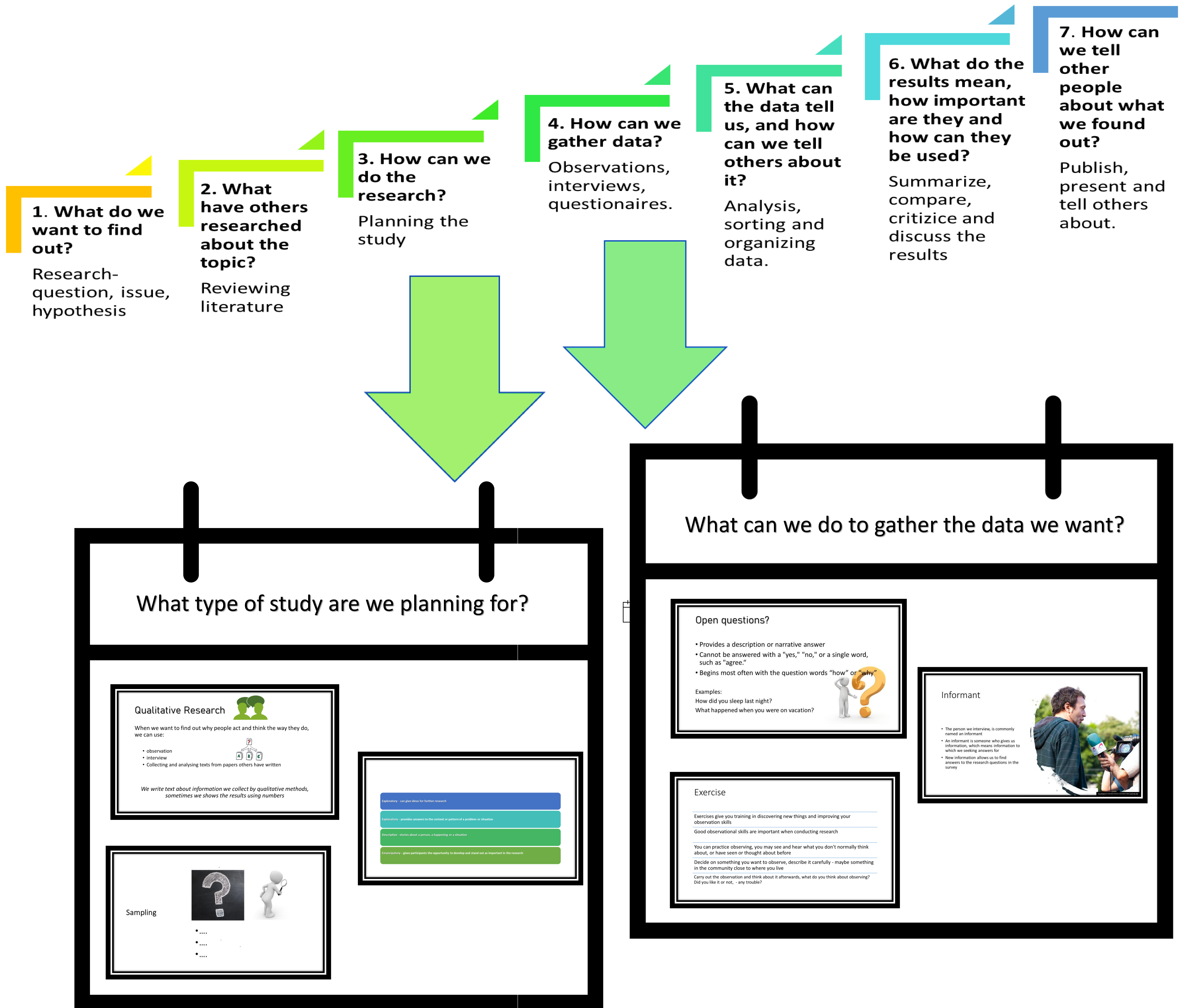


RESEARCH METHOD
